The 43rd Asian Conference on Remote Sensing (ACRS2022) will be held on 3-5 October, 2022 in Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia. The conference is expected to be an interdisciplinary forum for leading researchers and students in related areas to present the latest developments, works, and applications, to discuss cutting-edge technology, to exchange research ideas, and to promote international collaboration in this field.

ACRS 2022 will be organized in hybrid mode both onsite and online. However, considering the unclear condition of Covid-19, international participants are recommended to participate online. Accordingly, the dates of ACRS2022 will be reduced from five days to three days.
